
Hydrofoil Stabilizer Kit For Outboard Motors and I/O Drives

CAUTION: NEVER RUN ENGINE WHILE INSTALLING STABILIZERS

- 1. Tilt outboard or stern drive to upright position.
- Position Hydrofoil fins onto the cavitation plate as far forward as possible making sure both sides are parallel and even.
- 3. Using the pre-drilled holes as a guide, mark each hole and remove hydrofoil.

 Once the drill hole locations are marked on the engine use the ¼ in drill to clear the marking guide from the holes on the stabilizer.



- 4. Using a ¼ in metal drill bit, carefully drill each hole in the cavitation plate.
- 5. Reinstall the hydrofoil fins.
- 6. Bolt the hydrofoils onto cavitation plate using provided hardware.
