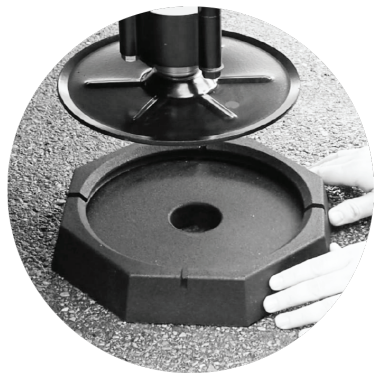

Installation Happens In a “Snap”!



Step #1:

Line up the pad
beneath your jack.



Step #2:

Lower the foot
until the lip fully engages.



Step #3:

Repeat for the rest
of your jacks.

Quick Tips

- Install one SnapPad at a time.
- Get a helper! SnapPad installation is easier with two people.
- Install your pads while parked on a hard, flat, even surface like concrete or asphalt.
- If your SnapPad package comes with different sized pads, **be sure to match the correct SnapPad with the proper jack on your rig.**
- Use a bead of dish soap around the lip of your SnapPad as lube for the installation.
- **Do not use any silicone-based products on your SnapPads!** They compromise the integrity of the rubber material.
- **If installing on a Class A Motorhome, be sure to stay clear until the airbags have deflated.**
